Ambroxol blocked P/Q-, N-, and R-type channels (Ca v 2.1, Ca v 2.2, and Ca v 2.3, respectively) in a recombinant system with comparable potency (IC 50 values around 100 µmol/L) and showed no preference for certain channel subtypes. Thus, ambroxol appears to be rather nonselective in respect to the blockade of neuronal Ca 2+ channels.
