Burn trauma elevates catecholamines for up to 2 years and causes hypertrophic scarring. Propranolol, a nonspecific β_1 -, β_2 -adrenergic receptor (AR) inverse agonist, counters the hypermetabolic response to elevated catecholamines and may decrease hypertrophic scarring by an unknown mechanism.

Nitric Oxide and Endothelial Cell Dysfunction. A major conceptual advance in the field of Vascular Cell Biology was the demonstration that the endothelial lining is a source of various autocooid factors that can influence the behavior of other types of cells within the vessel wall (pericytes, smooth muscle) and in the circulating blood (platelets and leukocytes).
