The Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Visitor Center is on the grounds of the 17-acre (69,000 m²) Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad State Park.. The visitor center consists of 15,000 square feet (1,400 m²) of exhibition and administrative spread over four buildings. Visitors enter through a south door, and proceed through a series of corridors and galleries to the north.
